



2,4-D Amine

Recommended uses

Weeds best controlled as seedlings. Use lower rates on seedlings.

Use Autumn, early Winter or early Spring

Weeds controlled in:

cereals

hedge mustard, thistles, wild turnip, black nightshade, seedling docks, fathen, shepherds purse, calandrinia, nettles

pasture

buttercups (except giant) hedge mustard, thistles, catsear, dandelions, nettle, plantains, seedling docks, fathen

Application rates

Cereals: Use 1.5-3 L/ha and apply while weeds are at the 2-6 leaf stage and growing actively. Spray when the crop is between the 5 leaf stage and jointing. Do not use on cereal crops undersown with clovers.

Pasture: 3-4 L/ha for thistles, annual buttercups and hedge mustard.

4-6 L/ha for other weeds, see label for further information.

Livestock withholding

Keep off pastures until the plants have died down.

Clovers

May be damaging to clovers especially red clover in Spring and Autumn

Graze area before spraying to reduce clover and expose weeds.
