EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 764 766

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or Leak	Wear overalls, chemical resistant boots and gloves (barrier multilayer, nitrile), and safety goggles. Prevent further spillage or leakage. Absorb spilled product and place in a sealable container. Wash affected area with water detergent solution. Absorb washings and place in sealed container. Dispose of to a suitable landfill or other suitable facility.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing including self-contained breathing apparatus. Toxic fumes may be released. Keep people away. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical, carbon dioxide or fine water spray. Cool other containers to prevent rupture. Contain run-off.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	Do NOT induce vomiting. Immediately call the NATIONAL POISON CENTRE (0800 764 766) or doctor/physician. If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.
If in Eyes:	Hold eyes open and rinse with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if easy to do so. For advice call the National Poison Centre 0800 764 766 or a doctor immediately.
If on Skin:	Immediately wash affected area with soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Call a doctor or national poison centre for advice if irritation persists.
If Inhaled:	Immediately move patient to fresh air and rest. Maintain half upright position if breathing is difficult. For advice call the National Poison Centre 0800 764 766 or a doctor immediately.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry, ventilated place away from direct heat or direct sunlight. Store away from foodstuffs, children and animals. Keep container sealed when not in use.
